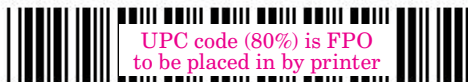

Churchill Downs and its fabled Twin Spires are worldwide symbols of horse racing tradition and pride. The historic racetrack located in Louisville, Kentucky, is one of the most hallowed shrines in American sport. Since its founding in 1874, Churchill Downs has hosted the nation's top Thoroughbreds in competition for some of the sport's largest purses, including the Breeders' Cup World Championships a record seven times. First won by Aristides in 1875, the Kentucky Derby is the oldest continuously held sporting event in the nation and the first jewel of the Triple Crown.

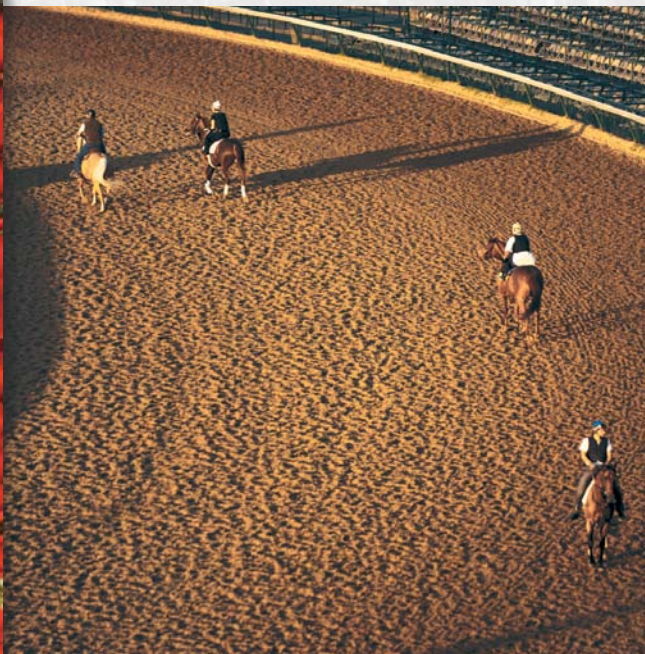

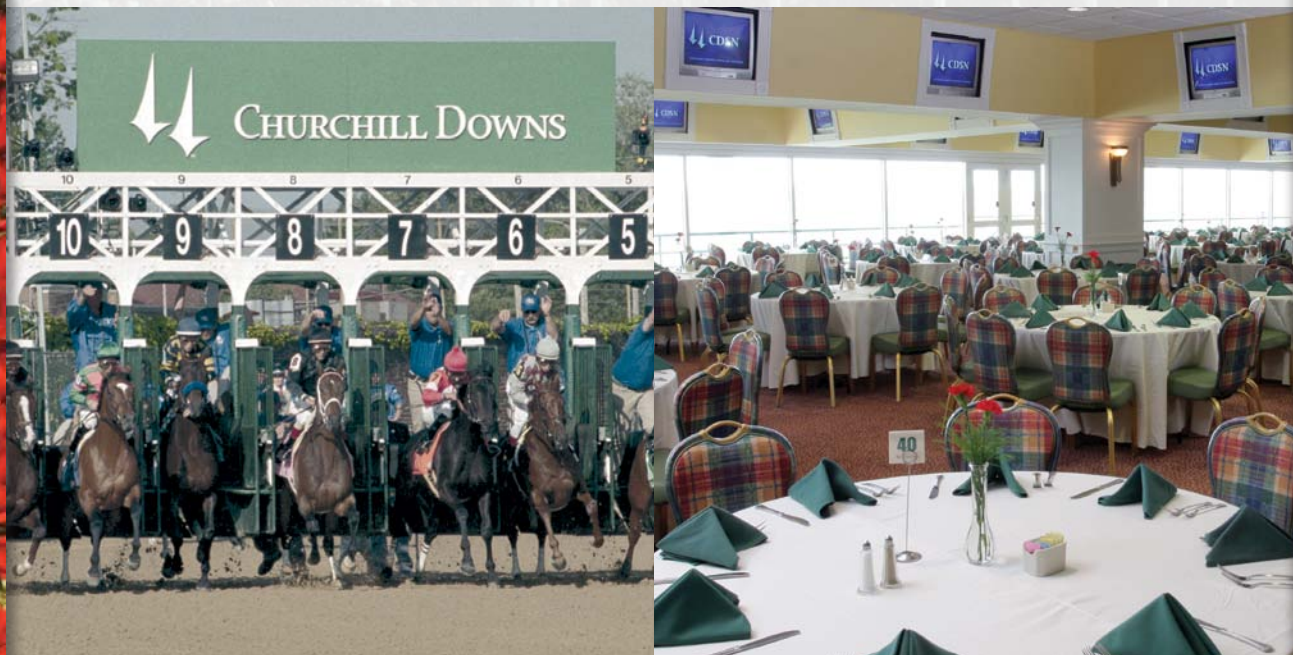

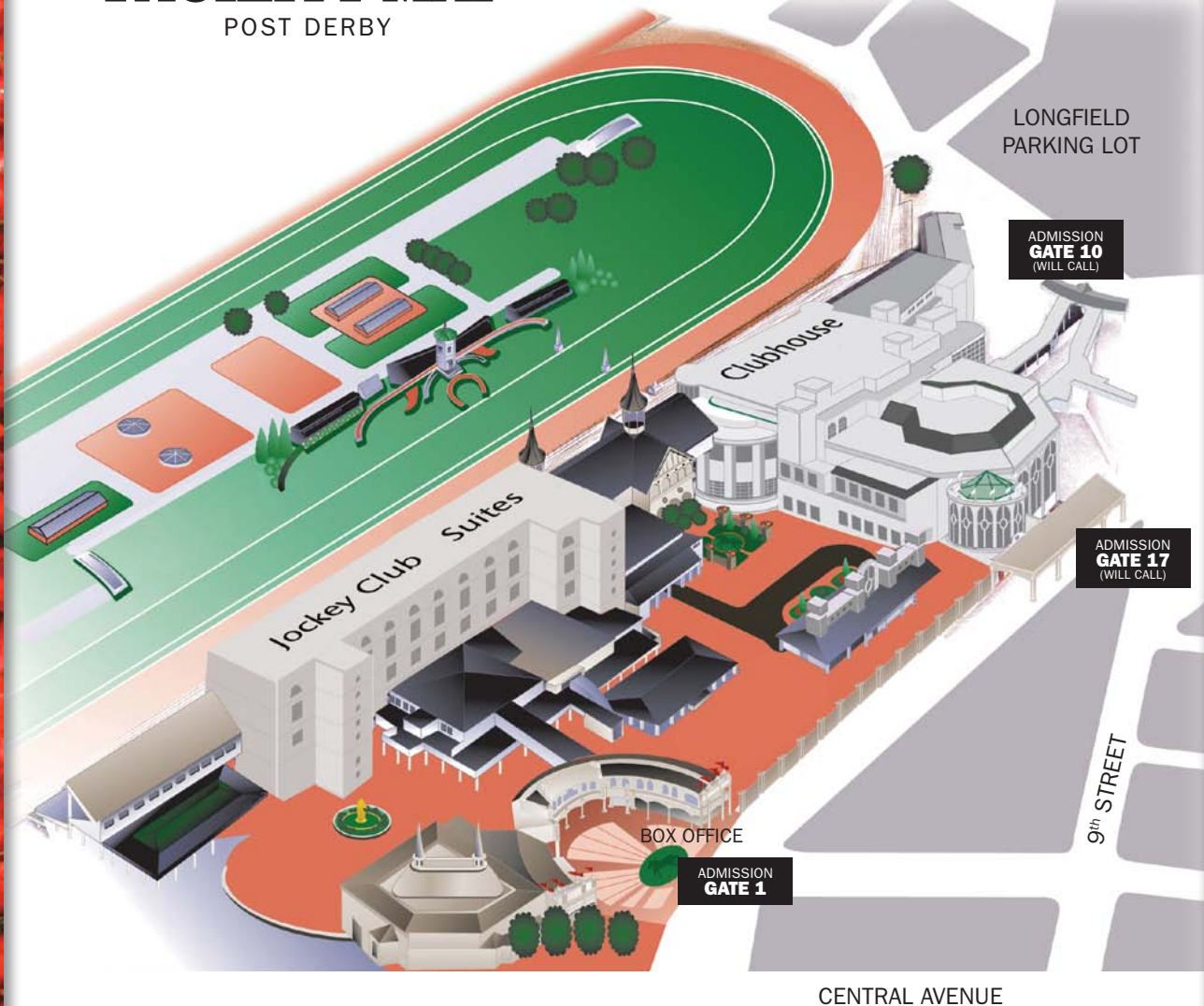

## TRACK SEATING

During the race meets, covered and open seating is available on a first-come, first-served basis in first-floor Clubhouse sections 110-118. The second-floor simulcast area offers carrels and tables at no charge as well as free seating inside the Silks Lounge. Seating is also available in select reserved Clubhouse box seat areas. Tickets are sold at the Reserved Seating Booths located inside Admission Gates 10 and 17 or may be purchased in advance by visiting [tickets.churchilldowns.com](https://tickets.churchilldowns.com) or calling (502) 636-4400.

## HANDICAP ACCESSIBILITY
